In the event of cancellation, written notifications must be sent to the IIA Sweden by email to [GRC2019@theiia.se](mailto:GRC2019@theiia.se)

The following cancellation rates will apply:

- Cancellations received from April 1<sup>st</sup> through July 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 will incur 50 % of the ticket cost.
- There are no refunds for cancellations received after July 1<sup>st</sup> 2019.
- Delegates may nominate an alternative person from their organization to attend the latest on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2019. Written notification must be sent to the IIA Sweden by e-mail to [GRC2019@theiia.se](mailto:GRC2019@theiia.se)
- All refunds will be processed and issued no later than 30 days after the event.
- If you have made an accommodation booking, you are responsible for cancelling this separately. The IIA Sweden takes no responsibility for any financial penalties you may incur.
