All cancellations are to be made in writing, by sending an email to grconference@theiia.se

The following cancellation rates will apply:

- We offer full refund for cancellations received before May 11th.
- Cancellations received from May 11th through June 15th 2020 will incur 50 % of the ticket cost.
- There are no refunds for cancellations received after June 15th 2020.
- Delegates may nominate an alternative person from their organization to attend the latest on October 1st 2020. A written notification is to be sent in that case grconference@theiia.se
- All refunds will be processed and issued no later than 30 days after the event.
- If you have made an accommodation booking, you are responsible for cancelling this separately. The IIA Sweden takes no responsibility for any financial penalties you may incur.
