Terms and Conditions

The following cancellation terms apply:

Earlier tickets, as well as Early Bird tickets:

- Participants may change ticket type or cancel their ticket entirely up to and including **March 12th 2021**.
- After this date only ticket upgrades are possible (changing from a lower price to a higher price ticket).

Standard tickets:

- Participants may change ticket type or cancel their ticket entirely up to and including **March 31st 2021**.
- After this date only ticket upgrades are possible (changing from a lower price to a higher price ticket)

Ticket upgrades are based on the prices available at the time of the registration. E.g. if the initial registration for 4 May occurred during the Early Bird period, and the upgrade to 4 + 5 May occurs after the Early Bird period, the Early Bird price for 4 + 5 May will apply.

Participants may nominate an alternative person from their organization to take over the ownership of the ticket up to and including **April 16th 2021**. Changes in ticket ownership must be notified by e-mail to grconference@theiia.se

Late Bird tickets are non-cancellable and non-refundable.
